The history of the Tokyo Dome City began in 1937 with the establishment of a baseball stadium on the site of a former military factory. During Japan's postwar rehabilitation, the company expanded its facilities to include an Ice Palace, Roller Skating Rink and Amusement Park. 1988 saw the opening of Japan's first air dome, Tokyo Dome. At present, the City receives approximately 35 million visitors per year and is regarded as one of the largest entertainment area in Tokyo.
